

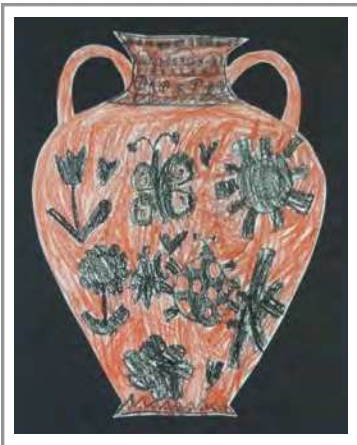
ART SPOTTIDINGS

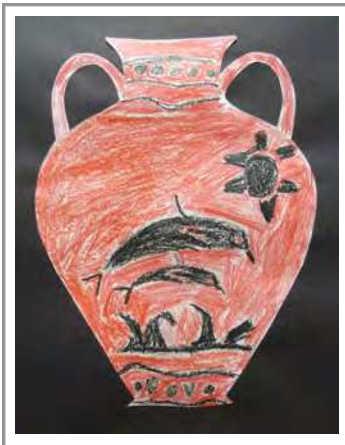

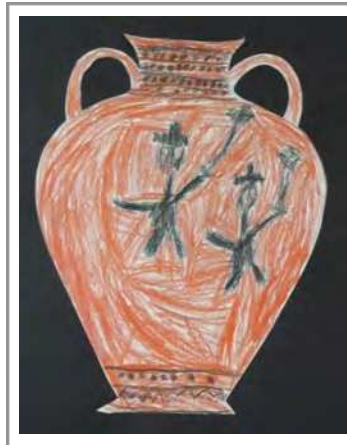

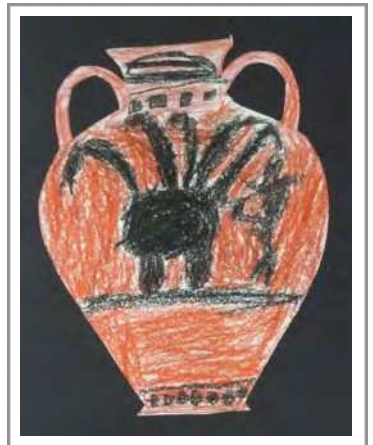
