

One-Point Perspective

Perspective was one of the great discoveries of the Renaissance, allowing the accurate representation of depth in two-dimensional art. Da Vinci famously used one-point perspective to direct attention to Jesus' face in his "Last Supper". To practice this technique, the students set up perspective lines and drew a picture that would emphasize the vanishing point to maximize the three-dimensional effect.

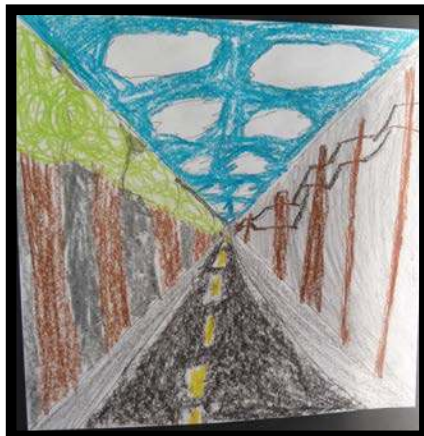
