

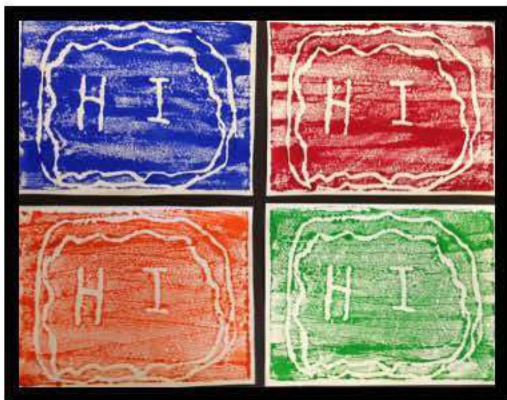
ART SPOT Snap Shots

Printmaking

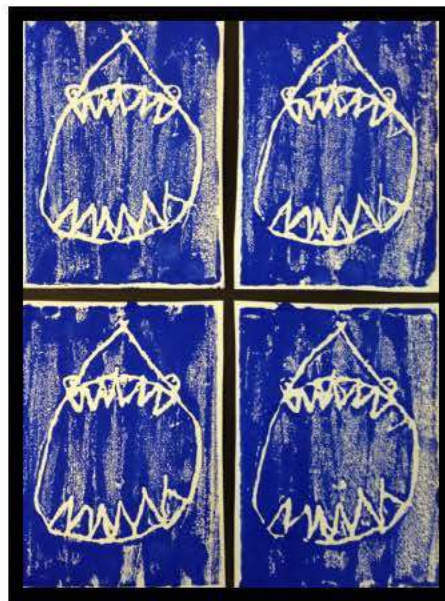
Printmaking offered some Renaissance artists, such as Albrecht Durer, a way to mass produce their art. By inking a carved block the same image can be reproduced many times with minimal effort.

(This mass production was itself turned into an art form by Andy Warhol.)

The third grade students learned some of the tricks for engraving and then produced an image on foam from which they made prints (showing hints of both styles).
