Below is a list of supplies to start the year off, but it is not a complete list. Teachers can specify other required materials during the year.

Backpacks should be solid in color or have a simple pattern.

All Students

- Students will need 3-ring binders for their subjects. Specific requirements will be noted below.
 - For students who are well organized, 7th and 8th grade Classical Studies, Geography, and 7th grade Latin are subjects that can be combined with other subjects in one binder.
 - For students who are developing their organizational skills, it can help to dedicate a single binder to each subject, with subjects with less materials getting a ½” or ¾” inch binder.
- Scientific calculator (similar to TI30XIIS)
- Pens (red, blue, and black)
- Pencils and erasers
- Highlighters
- Loose leaf college ruled notebook paper
- Loose leaf ¼-inch graph paper
- Clear plastic ruler with metric scale
- Box of Kleenex
